

Template for the Management Plan for Low ILUC Risk Feedstock Certification

Please read the guidelines carefully before using this template!

- This document is to be applied for low ILUC risk certification audits economic operators aiming for low ILUC risk certification. It can be used to fulfil the requirement, that a filled out low ILUC risk management plan must be available for the audit.
- The document must be filled out by the economic operator aiming for low ILUC risk certification.
- In case of group certification under a first gathering point (FGP) or a Central Office, this
 template can also be used by all group members to document respective low ILUC risk
 additionality measures
- In case of group certification, the economic operator (Central Office/ FGP) must also provide the following documents/ data
 - List of all farmers/ small holders being part of the group being covered under the low ILUC risk add-on, including name and address
- In case of a group certification, the group members (small holder(s), farm(s)) can also use the template. In this case, the following sections have to be filled out:
 - o Description of the farm / delineated plot of land
 - o Options to qualify as additionality measure
 - Additionality measure(s) and expected yields (Option 1)
 - o Calculation of the dynamic yield baseline (Option 1)
 - o Demonstration of land status (Option 2)
- In case of group certification, the economic operator being certified (FGP, Central Office) must fill out the following chapter:
 - o Basic data low ILUC risk certification holder
 - o Calculation of the dynamic yield baseline (Option 1)
 - o Demonstration of additionality (Option 1)
 - Estimation of additional biomass yield
- Information on the delineated plot of land can be provided in a digital format (e.g. shape file, KML file) including information on ownership, land use history, yields, etc.
- The management plan must allow a comparison to be made between the use of the delineated plot before and after implementation of the additionality measure

	Required information	Description
2.22	Provision of crop-specific information on historic yields. If possible, data must also be linked to the delineated plot of land. The data set must include annual historical crop yields for the three years before the implementation of the additionality measure.	
	In case the data is not available or sufficient, other data (older) or alternative data sources can be used. For further guidance, the guidance document provides more detailed information.	
2.23	Calculation of the dynamic yield baseline according to the methodology described in the Guidance document. The baseline must be crop-specific, determined for each delineated plot and determined for each type or combination of additionality measure(s) applied.

	Required information	Description
2.31	Documentation of an analysis on the financial attractiveness of the additionality measure showing that the NPV (Net Present Value) of the measure is negative OR	
	Documentation of a barrier analysis proving that factors inhibit the uptake of the additionality measures.

2.41	Information on the land status of the delineated plot(s) (Proof of land status). If cultivation takes place on previously abandoned or severely degraded land this qualifies as an additionality.	
	2.5 Estimation of addition	onal biomass yield
	Required information	Description
2.51	Estimation on the effectiveness of the additionality measure and estimation on the additional biomass being produced. Please explain, which data sources have been used to determine the additional yield as expectations must be reasonable (e.g. refer to scientific literature, experience from field trials, information provided from seeding companies). In case the additionality has been implemented in the past, documentation on the yields achieved shall be taken into	

account.
